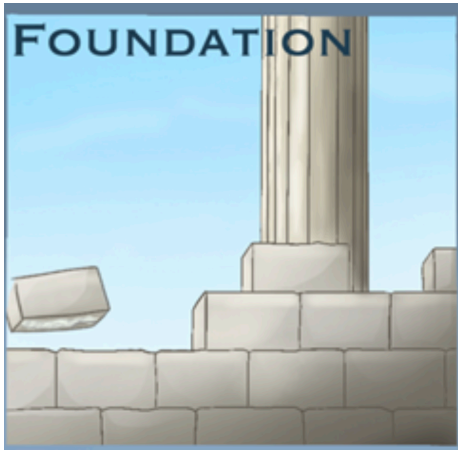

Redemption means to “buy back.” Jesus redeems us by giving His life for us.

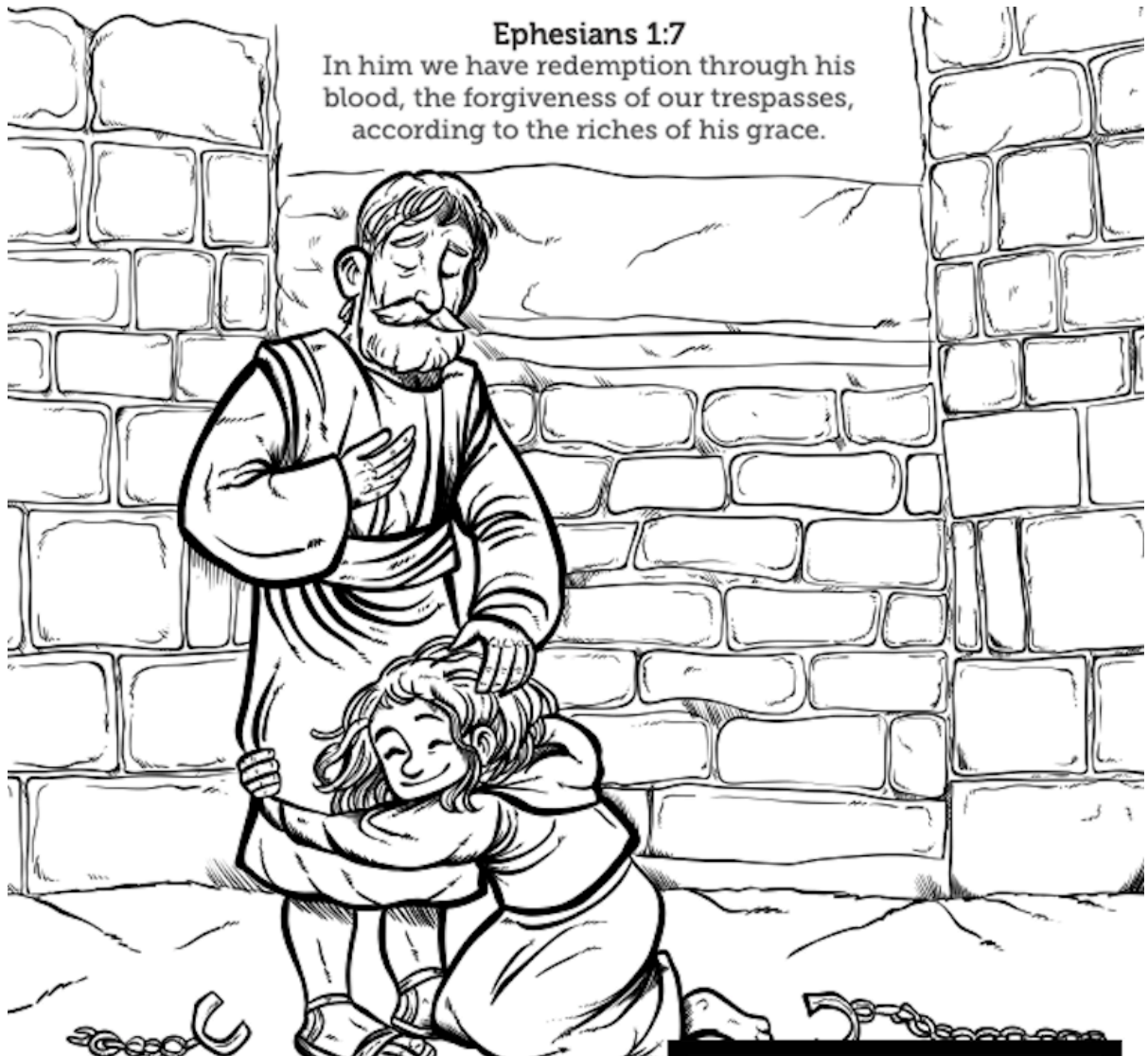


Jesus purchased
