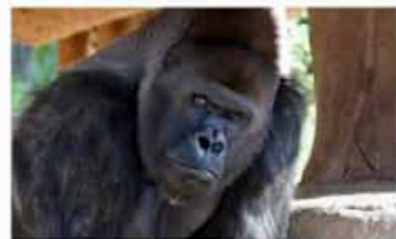
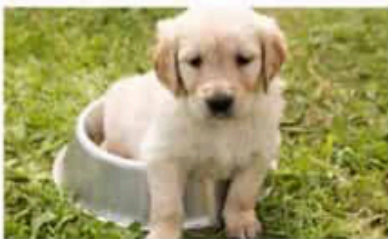
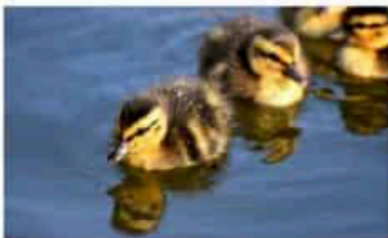
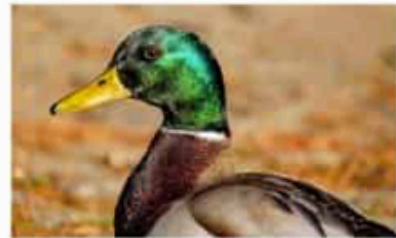
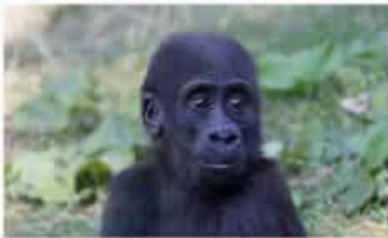
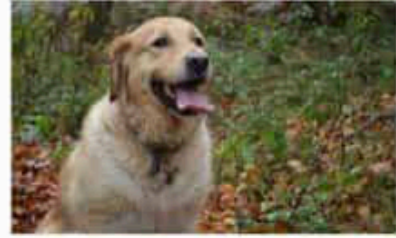
God is our

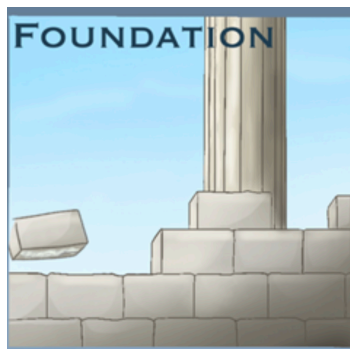
